Adopted in 1890, the year of our university's founding, the seal features:

- An eternal flame as a reminder of academic achievement and excellence.
- The Lone Star, representing the great state of Texas.
- Olive and live oak branches, signifying peace and strength.

#### THE McCONNELL MEMORIAL TOWER

- The two clock faces on the tower.
- One hand at 1 o'clock, signifying the internationally recognized One O'Clock Lab Band.
- The other hand at 7, recalling the evening curfew for students at Texas Normal College and Teacher Training Institute in 1892.
